- **Trade Only:** Fri., May 27th 8:00-8:45am
Use "credit slip" issued during Turn-In to get next year's books—limited to the same number of books you turned in on previous days .No price haggling nor shipment hassles!!
- **Purchase or Trade :** Fri, May 27th 8:45-11:30am
Purchase books not obtained during "Trade Only "but needed for next year
- **Purchase or Trade for Duplicate Copies :** Fri. May 27th 9:30 –11:30 am
Buy a second set, based on availability, for home use
