Whitefield Academy has announced plans to build a \$24 million expansion on its 100-acre campus in Smyrna.

The new Lower School academic building will house 270-300 students and include classrooms, administrative offices and library space for pre-K through fourth grade. It will bear the name Brostrand Hall in honor of Lower School Principal Jeannie Brostrand, who will be retiring soon after 12 years in the position.

Brostrand Hall will be accessible through a new dedicated entrance gate.

The school also announced a capital fundraising campaign to fund the new building's construction, having already raised about \$14.1 million.

The campaign will also contribute toward construction of a dining and kitchen expansion to the school's athletic center, which also serves as cafeteria space for middle and upper school students and staff. That expansion is expected to be complete by the end of 2018.
