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**Whitefield Academy** opened its doors to students in grades six through twelve in 1997 in suburban Atlanta's northwest region. Grades kindergarten through five were added in 2002 and PreK4 in 2005. Current enrollment is more than 850 students, 29 percent of whom are students of color, with approximately 300 students in the Upper School.
