Advanced Academic Offerings

AP eligibility is based on grades, test scores, and faculty recommendations. Students may take a maximum of one AP class in their sophomore year, three AP classes in their junior year, and four AP classes in their senior year. AP coursework is available in the 11th and 12th grades, with limited availability to 10th graders. Students enrolled in AP courses are required to take the corresponding exams. 90% of students who take AP Exams score at 3 or higher.
