About Whitefield Academy

Whitefield Academy opened in 1997 with grades six through twelve, added kindergarten through grade five in 2002, and PreK4 in 2005. Current enrollment is 937 students, 25 percent of whom are students of color, with approximately 392 students in the Upper School. Students participate in over 50 sports teams across 14 sports, more than 75 fine arts performances annually, 40+ clubs and organizations, and contribute over 10,000 hours of community service each year, with more than 20,700 service hours completed since June 2025.

Students are required to earn a grade of 70 or higher for each semester to obtain course credit.

On the transcript, AP and Honors course grades are unweighted. GPA is weighted with AP courses +1.0 and Honors courses +.5.

Due to the rigorous nature of our program, Whitefield Academy does not calculate class rank.

Advanced Academic Offerings

AP eligibility is based on grades, test scores, and faculty recommendations. Students may take a maximum of one AP class in their sophomore year, three AP classes in their junior year, and four AP classes in their senior year. AP coursework is available in the 11th and 12th grades, with limited availability to 10th graders. Students enrolled in AP courses are required to take the corresponding exams. 87 percent of students who take AP exams score at 3 or higher.
